Highway Access Report:

A proposed drawing has been received to complete the second set of drawings for the Highway Access Project. The third option drawings have been requested to be sent to us a week prior to our next Board Meeting in August.

Park Progress & Community Centre: Park: A cement picnic table package has been delivered to the Meadowood Community Park for future assembly. We have purchased this new picnic table at a cost of just over \$1,100.00 to replace the non-repairable wooden picnic table that was vandalized. An anonymous donation of \$500., along with \$600. approved from our Operating budget, will cover the replacement costs. Unfortunately, we note another wooden picnic table at the Park has also been vandalized to the extent that we may be required to replace a second table at the Park soon.

<u>Community Centre:</u> Further to the decision in May, 2016 by the Regional District of Nanaimo Board of Directors to reject all Proposals and terminate the Request for Proposal process for the Design-Build of the Meadowood Community Centre, we have now learned new information on this situation as per the following excerpt from the R.D.N. Board Meeting of June 28, 2016:
