

PROPOSED HIGHWAY 19 INTERCHANGE AT NAHMINT ROAD



Various Ministry (Transport and Environment) requirements and restrictions are associated with accessing Highway 19 at the Corcan Road overpass and several options have been considered. The above option is restriction/requirement compliant and makes use of existing roadways, which will minimize construction and related costs. A right turn lane connected to Nahmint Road, is all that would be required for traffic from the south to exit Hwy. 19. Traffic from the north would exit Hwy. 19 via a left turn (controlled by lights) leading onto Nahmint Road. Nahmint Road would also accommodate access onto the highway from Corcan Road. A right turn off Nahmint would take you north and left turn (controlled by lights) would enable southbound traffic.

The 'Corcan-Meadowood Residents Association' has been established as a non-profit organization to provide residents with a vehicle and voice for identifying and accomplishing this and other development/improvement projects in our area.
