This will go before the R.D.N. Board of Directors Regular Meeting on Jan. 26th, 2016 for ratification. Requests for Proposals (Tenders) should go out in February which will start the process. Timing of project will be determined once the Tenders have closed and the Design/Build Tender is awarded.
