 Chris will touch base with R.D.N. Area "F" Director to discuss Emergency Access plans.
- Park Progress & Community Centre: Alf Jablonski presented a detailed "Proposal of Intent" for discussion and forwarding to the Regional District of Nanaimo. This Letter of Intent will be part of the package for approval by the Regional District Board of Directors to continue the process for the Community Hall build project. Once that package passes approval, Requests for Proposal (RFP's) may then be Issued/posted.
- <u>Special Events (Halloween):</u> Plans for 2019 Halloween Event will be addressed later in the spring. Approval has been received for our application for Recreational Grant from the Regional District of Nanaimo which will be utilized for that event in October, 2019.
- Neighbourhood Emergency Preparedness: Winter Storm season continued with a "blast", quite literally, on December 20th, 2018 with our area being hit particularly hard. The devastation and damage caused by the strong 'twister'-like winds lasting for several hours, was unlike anything ever experienced here, to present knowledge. Residents are to be commended for everything they did to assist their neighbours, keep calm, deal with lengthy power outages and weather the situation (pun intended). Clean-up and repairs will take quite a while to get things back to normal.

Even household garbage is being dumped in a certain area at the East end of Ashling Rd. near Meadowood. This only attracts wildlife presenting a danger for pedestrians and children.
