

## **PURPOSE OF THE BYLAWS**

The purpose of the bylaws is to realign zoning and OCP land use designation boundaries for the subject properties, to facilitate a 9-Lot subdivision and land exchange of private lands and RDN parkland. The proposed subdivision will result in six new village residential lots; a separate lot for the existing Meadowood Fire Hall; additional road dedication to connect Ashling Road to Galvin Place; and, an exchange of community and regional parkland to improve public access to both the Little Qualicum River Regional Park and the Meadowood Community Park. ### **HAVE YOUR SAY**

All persons who consider their interest in their property to be affected by the proposed bylaws shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard in person or by written submission at the public hearing. Written submissions can be provided in advance of the public hearing and must be received at the RDN office by **4:30 p.m. Monday, November 14, 2022,** to ensure their inclusion in the public record. Written submissions may be submitted by email to *planning@rdn.bc.ca* or by mail or in person to 6300 Hammond Bay Road, Nanaimo, B.C., V9T 6N2.
